We're looking for an excellent coach who also wants to help grow the women's game at the club over time. This role will sit under the foundation with a line into the CEO and technical staff in the men's first team and academy.

Purpose of the job

Reporting to the Community Director you will lead and oversee the Women's First Team. You will manage weekly training sessions and attend match days throughout the season. You will be the lead contact for the women's football at Grimsby Town FC.

Main Roles & Responsibilities

- Recruit players through trials and retain a full squad throughout the season
- Recruit support staff i.e. Assistant Coach, performance practitioners
- Liaise with technical staff across the men's first team and academy
- Manage the operational budget for the team i.e. venue hire, kit equipment, travel etc

- Work with the Foundation to ensure links are made with the club's female pathway including the ETC, Foundation participation sessions and, from September a BTEC course
- Attend events as requested from time to time by the club to help promote the women's programme
